


Instructions for submitting papers to the 4th International Iranian Bioinformatics Conference

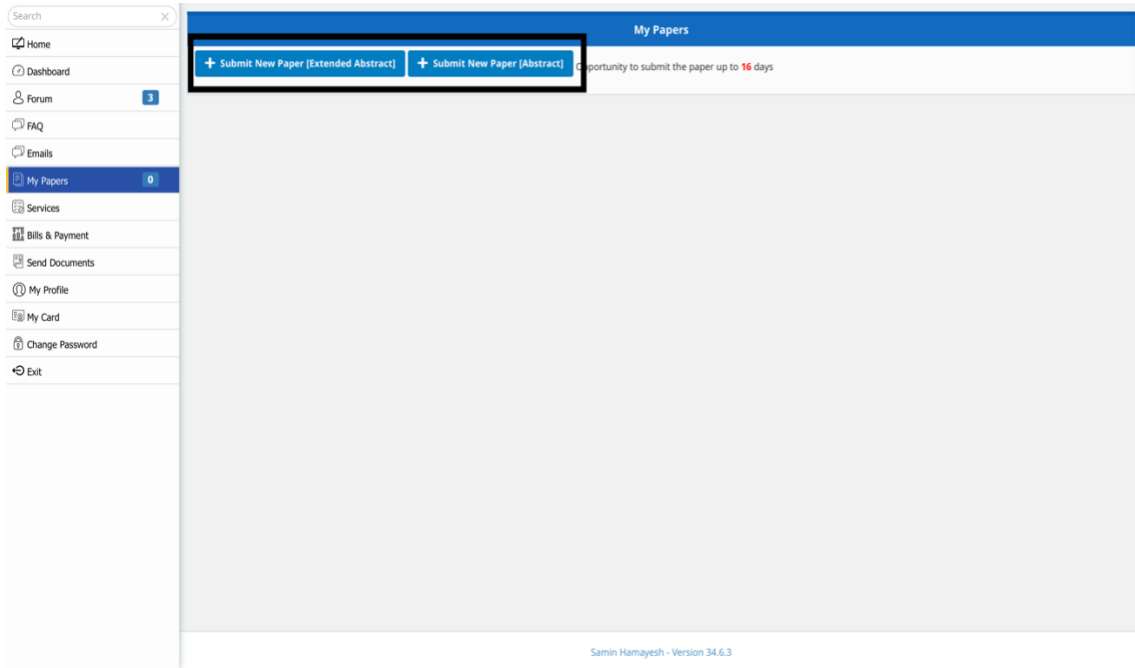
1. After logging into the conference dashboard at the address of the 4th International Iranian Bioinformatics Conference (<https://icb13.znu.ac.ir/panel/dashboard/user>), click on "My Papers" in the right-side menu of the site.

2. Once you select 'My Papers,' you'll be presented with a page where you'll need to choose between an 'Extended Abstract' and a 'Regular Abstract.' The choice depends on the type of paper you're submitting.





3. In this step, we will first register the abstract and then the extended abstract. After clicking on the 'Submit New Paper (Abstract)' button, you will see a page like this. We will provide the relevant explanations below the image.

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Field 1: The original language of your paper has been pre-selected for you, as the International Bioinformatics Conference only accepts English-language papers.

Field 2: Please select the main topic of your paper from the dropdown menu.

Field 3: Enter the title of your paper in English.

Field 4: Enter the abstract of your paper in English.

Field 5: Enter the keywords for your paper. Please note that a minimum of three and a maximum of five keywords are allowed.

Field 6: Enter the references for your paper. Copy and paste each reference, then press Enter to move to the next line. If a reference spans multiple lines, that is acceptable.


Field 7: Enter the information for the author(s) of your paper in the exact order as it appears in the paper.

Field 8: You must upload a PDF file of your abstract. Uploading a Word file is optional.

Field 9: Enter any additional comments or information about your paper. This field is completely optional.



- As mentioned in the conference's rules, regulations, and definitions (please refer [here](#)), for an extended abstract, it's crucial that your paper has been published in a reputable journal. Considering this point, you should proceed as shown in the figure on the extended abstract page.



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The only difference between uploading an extended abstract and a regular abstract lies in these specific sections. For an extended abstract, you must upload the original PDF file of your article and provide the link to the journal where it was published in the 'Additional Explanations' section. Please note that submitting the complete article file and the journal link is mandatory.

- Finally, by clicking the 'Submit' button, your paper will be successfully submitted to the reviewers, and you will be notified of the review results via email.
